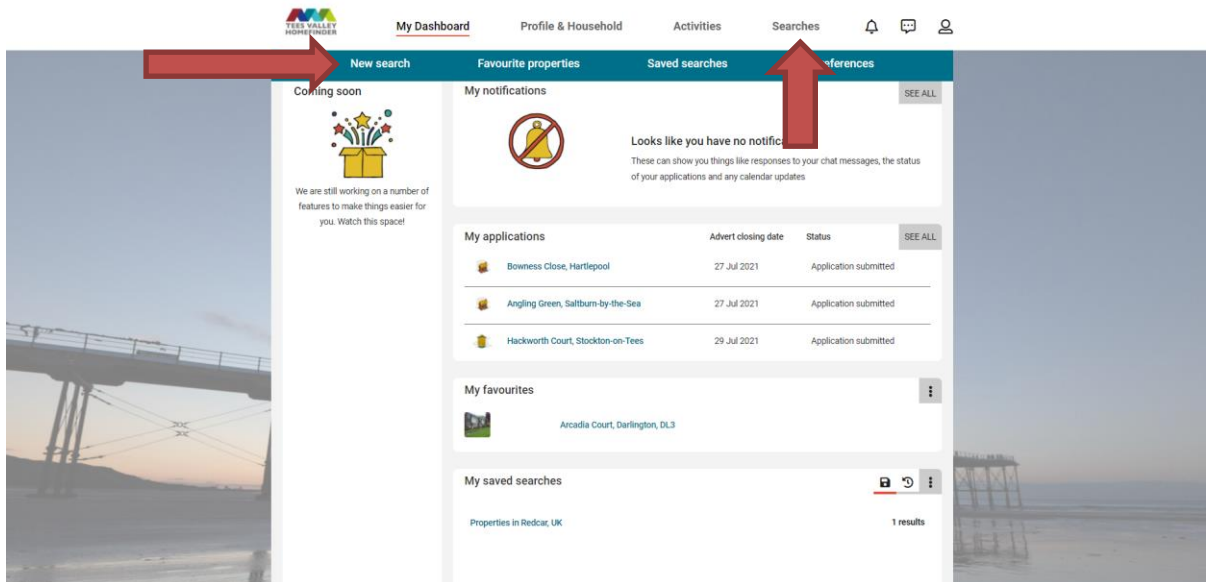


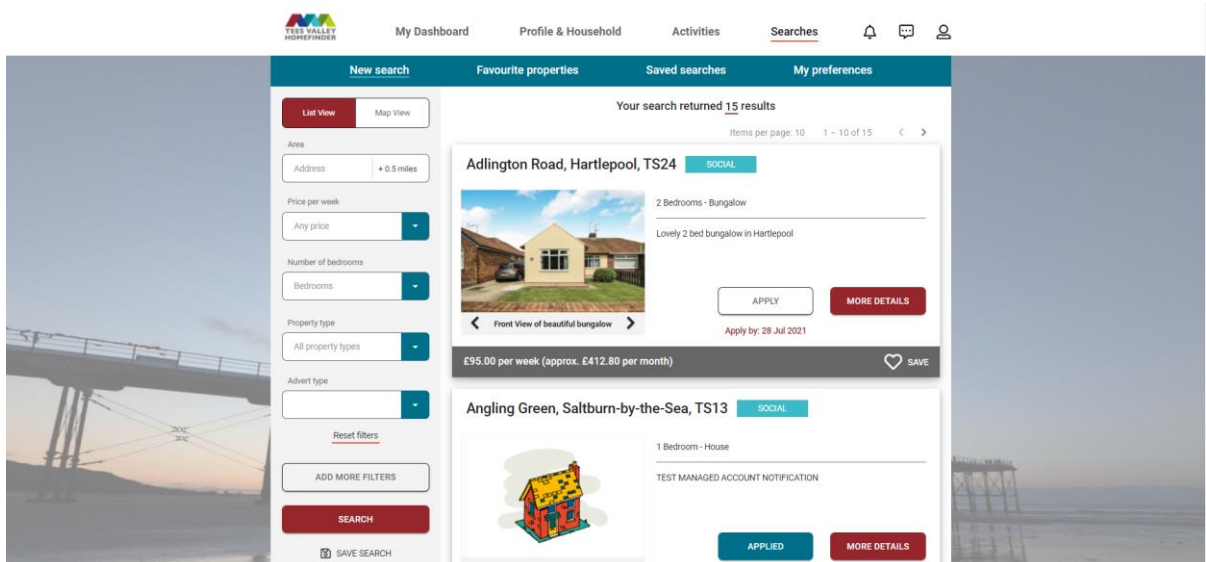


## Saved Searches

You can save searches for use the next time you log in to your account to save time. To do this, you need to search for a property using the 'Searches' option from your account.



Click 'Searches' then 'New Search'. This will take you to the Property Search screen.



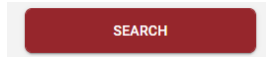
Using the search criteria boxes down the left-hand side of the screen, enter the details of the type/location/size of property you are looking for.

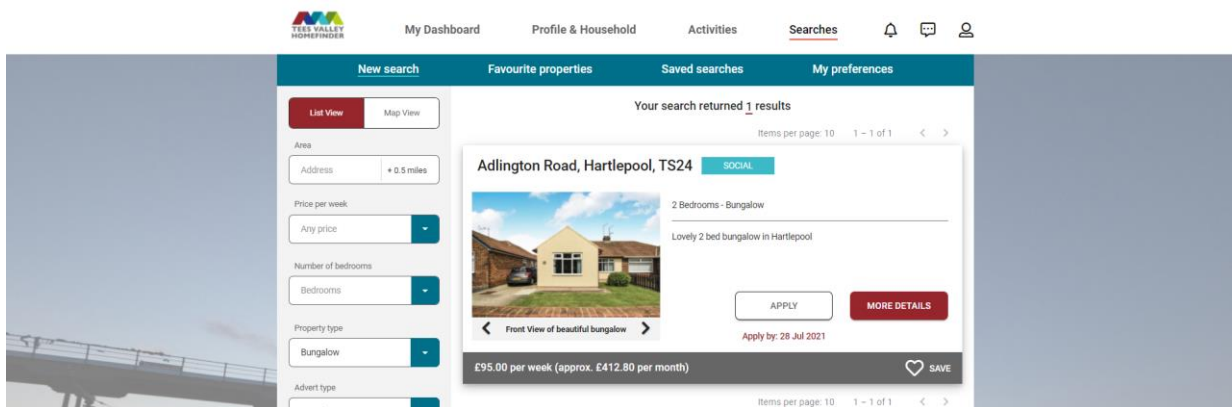


## Saved Searches

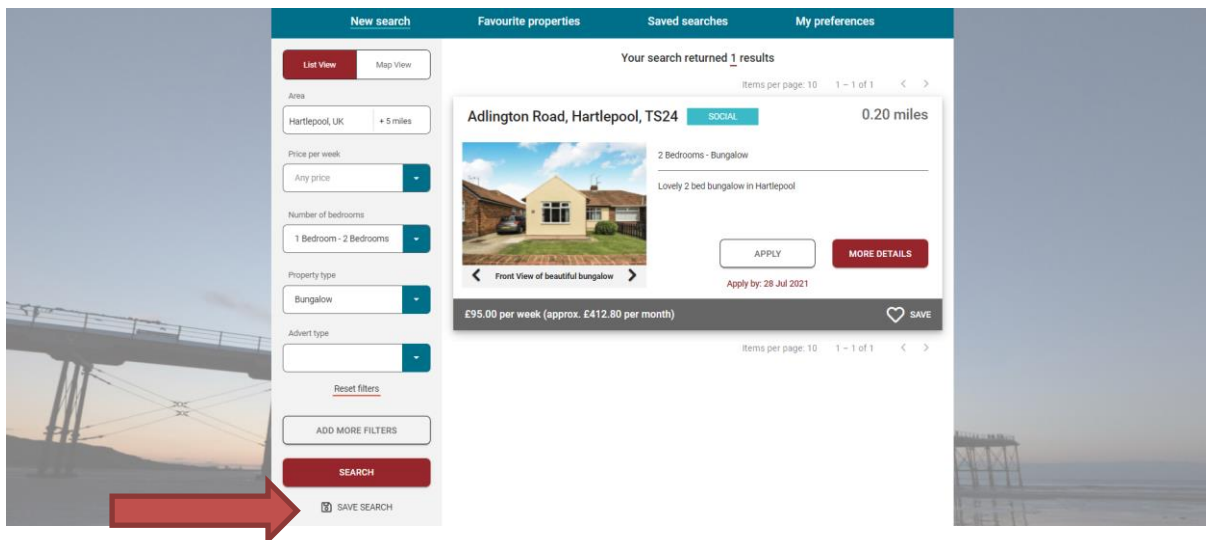
When you have added your filters, click the 'Search' button

To save this search, click on the 'Save' icon

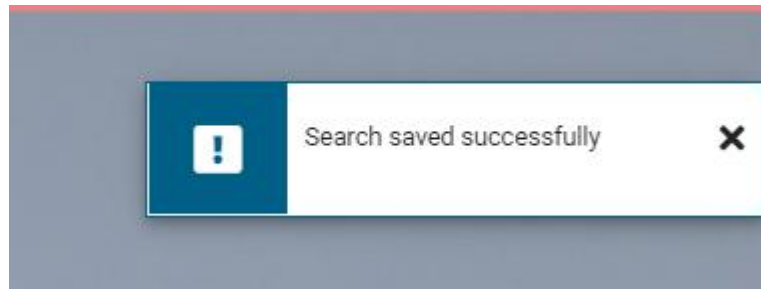


You will see a small alert appear in the top right-hand corner of your screen to confirm that your search has been saved.

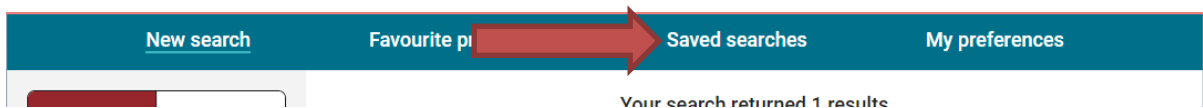


## Saved Searches

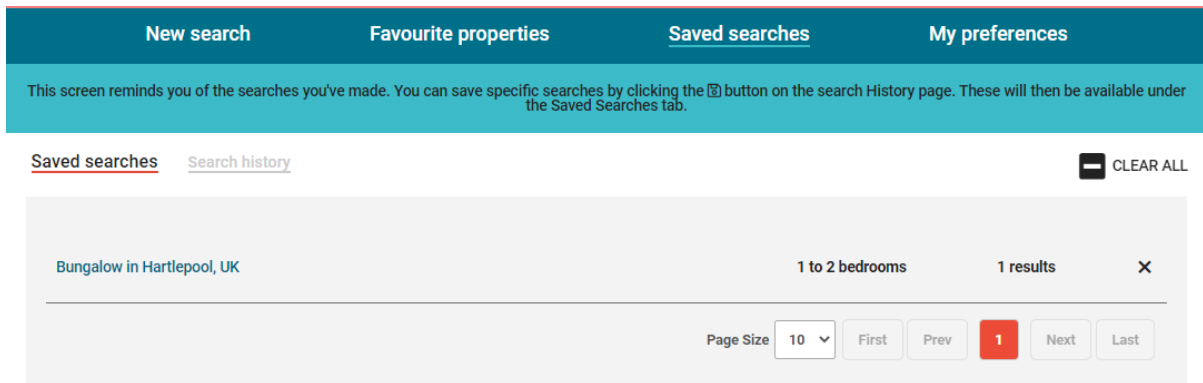


You can now access your saved searches from 2 different locations;

This will show you all of your saved searches and the number of results that you will get back if you run the search.



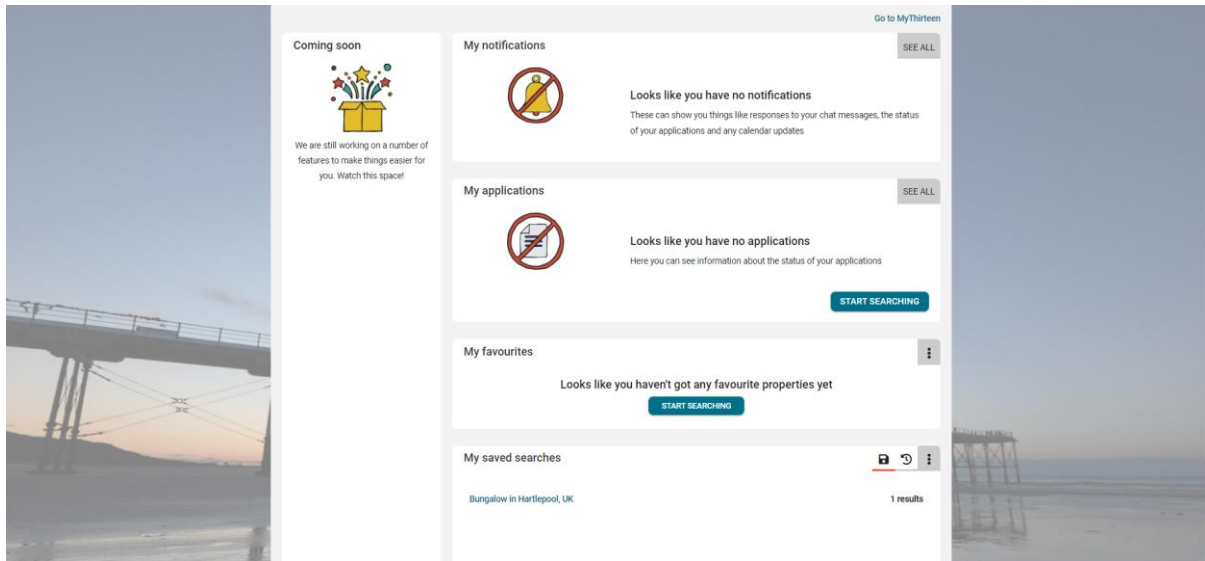
You can add multiple saved searches to this page for future use. To remove a saved search, just click on the ‘x’ icon next to it.
